- ② Venue: Mon Fri: Near the information desk, 1F, Main building

Sat, Sun, and holidays: Near ER entrance

- ③ Application form and receipt slip: You need to fill out a form with information such as patient's name, room number, and contents of the baggage.
- 4 Others: Ward staff regularly pick up and deliver the baggage to patient.
